

On 23.10.2017 The Foundation sponsored advance money to the rental premises for Jan Aashudhi Kendra started by Mr Suresh of Seelathikulam on 23.10.17.On 30.11.17, KOVISE Foundation sponsored space for five years to Mr Suresh to establish Jan Ashudhi Store in Seelathikulam Village, Radhapuram Taluk, Tirunelveli Dt in Tamil Nadu, under Native Village Development Programme.
